Inn-credible Golf a Matter of Course in Naples

NAPLES, Fla. – With nearly 1,600 beautifully-designed holes of golf, Naples is a perennial hotspot for golfers of all skill levels. Guests at The Inn on Fifth enjoy access to many of these courses, a number of which are private or semi-private, and can even have tee-times scheduled by the concierge. This authentic Naples property is the ideal headquarters for golf enthusiasts, as they tackle challenging, world-class courses designed by Robert Trent Jones, Sr., Raymond Floyd, Greg Norman and other golfing greats.

Currently, guests of The Inn on Fifth receive exclusive playing rights at Bear’s Paw Country Club and TPC Treviso Bay, two private courses just a short drive from the Inn. **Bear’s Paw** is a private course designed by golf legend Jack Nicklaus as his fifth signature course and his first in Florida. It is secluded within 244 acres of pristine natural landscape, and has hosted several Southwest Florida PGA Sectional Tournaments. Designed by Arthur Hills and Hal Sutton, the private **TPC Treviso Bay** is a 7,367-yard, par-72 course boasting 18-holes of beautifully maintained golf. The championship course is the only TPC network club in Southwest Florida and is built to PGA Tour standards.

Two of Naples other popular golf courses are also minutes from The Inn on Fifth at the Lely Resort. Designated by *Golfweek* as one of “America’s Best” and given a four-star rating by *Golf Digest*, the **Flamingo Island Course** at the Lely Resort does not disappoint. Hourglass fairways and countless fingered sand bunkers and large, undulating greens are all part of the masterpiece designed by golf mastermind, Robert Trent Jones, Sr. A highlight of the 7,171-yard course is the picturesque “Flamingo Island” hole – a 210-yard, three-tiered par 3 surrounded by water and two bunkers. **The Mustang Course** was expertly crafted by golf great Lee Trevino and follows his philosophy of making the game challenging, but fair for the average golfer. Towering pines, 12 sparkling lakes, rolling fairways, and strategically placed bunkers characterize Trevino’s 7,217-yard course.
