The Inn on Fifth Inn Review

Always Inn-Style

Located in the heart of fabulous Fifth Avenue, this authentic Naples boutique hotel captivates guests with an abundance of private terraces and signature pineapple finials. Once a Fifth Avenue bank building, the Inn opened in February of 1998 and is fashioned in the spirit of popular 1920's Palm Beach architect, Addison Mizner.

Fashionably Fifth Avenue

Naples, Florida

Set like a precious gem in the heart of Naples, The Inn on Fifth allows guests to stay centered by opening its doors onto a celebrated collection of upscale boutiques, antique shops, gourmet restaurants, sidewalk cafes, and one-of-a-kind art galleries. The Avenue offers a plethora of live music options nightly within walking distance of the hotel. The Inn is just a short sunny stroll from the white sand beaches of the emerald Gulf of Mexico.

Extravagant Accommodations

The distinctive downtown Inn features 87 spacious guest rooms, including 48 Deluxe Rooms, which provide an assortment of views, from the sparkling pool and tropical interior courtyard to fabulous Fifth Avenue. The 28 Plaza Rooms feature walkout balconies appointed with rattan rocking chairs. For truly luxurious living, the Inn offers five luxurious Junior Suites with oversized rooms, king beds, and Italian marble bathrooms; two Royal suites with Jacuzzi's; and four Terrace suites with a bedroom and living room, working desk and flat screen TV.

Ten rooms open directly onto the tropical poolside area, while an additional 10 rooms overlook the area from the third floor. With sliding French doors opening onto a balcony or terrace, each of the guest rooms and suites is decorated with rich tones and

classic European art. Standard luxuries include plush waffle-weave robes, iron and board, coffee makers, complimentary newspapers, hairdryer, iPod alarm clock/docking station, lavish pillow-top beds wrapped in silky cool 100 percent combed cotton sheets, laundry service, finest 100 percent cotton towels, in-room safe, three telephones, free Wi-Fi, computer and fax capabilities, voice mail, in-room movies, and cable television.

All guest bathrooms feature luxurious Travertini tile imported from Italy, as well as new shower doors and glass shelving. Bathrooms also include energy-efficient showers, recessed lighting, “green” paper products and an optional linen and towel change system.

The Inn on Fifth is expanding to include 32 new Club Level Suites in a brand new, three-story building directly across Fifth Avenue from the Inn’s current landmark location. The Club Level Suites range from 550 to 1160 square feet and offer large balconies, a separate check-in, private rooftop hot tub and sunbathing area, as well as breakfast, afternoon tea, and evening cocktails and appetizers. Scheduled completion is November 2012.

The Inn on Fifth is a “hotspot” with free Wi-Fi available in every room and throughout the inn. The property is Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant and non-smoking.

The Inn offers 7,879 square feet of space for a variety of meetings and events (2,779 air-conditioned, 5,100 open-air).

Distinctive Dining

McCabe's Irish Pub & Grill

Handcrafted in Dublin, then shipped to Naples and reconstructed on the Inn's first floor, this authentic Irish Pub delivers great food, lively music and one-of-a-kind ambiance. A local favorite, the Pub is adorned with Irish antiques and bric-a-brac, providing the perfect setting for a casual meal anytime of the day. Four high-definition widescreen LCD televisions enhance the "Irish sports pub" experience. Hearty fare such as traditional Irish stew, along with soups, salads, burgers and sandwiches, are served up for lunch and dinner in this spirited pub. The Pub & Grill is open seasonally for breakfast from 8 to 11 a.m. and daily for lunch, from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; and dinner, Sunday through Thursday from 6 to 10 p.m. and weekends until 11 p.m. On weekends, patrons can enjoy melodies from area musicians, with a lively blend of Irish and American tunes.

Truluck's Seafood, Steak and Crab House

Open daily for dinner at 5 p.m., Truluck's Seafood, Steak and Crab House surrounds guests in a semi-casual, yet sophisticated atmosphere with a cosmopolitan flair. The first of its kind in Florida, Truluck's is known for providing the freshest, top-quality Stone Crab claws from their own fisheries on the Isle of Capri, just 18 miles from the restaurant. Adjacent to McCabe's Irish Pub & Grill, the restaurant and bar offers more than 100 wines by the glass, including flight samplings for adventurous connoisseurs.

Fifth Avenue South

Guests have a wide array of options for dining and live music along trendy Fifth Avenue South. From gourmet dining to casual sidewalk cafés, Italian cuisine to Caribbean fare, Fifth Avenue South has 28 restaurants within four blocks of the Inn.

Inn Amenities

Soothing the Soul

The third floor of the Inn on Fifth is home to the luxurious Spa on Fifth, where guests can indulge in the finest all-natural products, an enticing selection of herbal treatments, highly-skilled staff, and

a tranquil atmosphere. Shaped by Feng Shui elements, the spa blends Asian influences with tropical accents for an award-winning design. A bold color palette of reds, golds and black emphasizes excitement and rejuvenation, while treatments such as the hot stone and harmony massage, or the chocolate raspberry brown sugar body scrub soothe the body, relax the mind and stimulate the senses. A variety of Vinotherapy treatments utilize grape seed and wine-making grape extracts and oils. Treatments include Vino Radiance Exfoliating Facial, Pinot Noir Vinotherapy Detoxing Wrap, and Vinotherapy Body Scrub. The spa has treatment and steam rooms, as well as men's and women's changing lounges.

Soaking It In

Guests soak in the Southwest Florida sun in the Inn's open-air courtyard, complete with waterfall, potted palms, birds of paradise and colorful hibiscus, all surrounding the rooftop pool and hot tub area. Guests can bask in the sun on colorful chaise lounges, as the sounds of the waterfall soothe the senses. The courtyard is also a perfect location for a wedding, cocktail reception or a custom catered affair. Temperatures below 60 degrees (F) in Naples are rare, but the pool is heated for year-round enjoyment.

Shaping Up

Hotel guests have 24-hour access to the state-of-the-art fitness center, fully equipped with Nautilus Nitro Pro equipment, including a vertical chest machine, overhead press, tricep extension, bicep curl, leg extension, seated leg curl and abdominal machine. Three treadmills and two elliptical machines give guests several workout options. The gym also includes the TrueStretch multi-purpose stretching program, free weights and flat screen TV's.

Seeing "Stars"

The Sugden Community Theater, home of the Naples Players and the von Liebig Art Center, is The Inn on Fifth's closest neighbor. Before or after the show, diners at McCabe's Irish Pub & Grill can enjoy a dinner and drinks under the stars on the patio.
